

# Cowboy Church Bass Club Tournament Results

Cedar Creek Lake - June 26, 2010 6:00 am to 3:30 pm

**Congratulations to Kevin Davis and Byron McFarland!** They brought an 11-lb 5-oz, 3 fish sack to the scales. The best stringer on the lake! Even the Media boys couldn't touch that. Throwing top water poppers in reeds near Log Cabin was the what put them ahead of the pack and earned them \$450.00.

**Charlie David caught the big bass** dragging a crank bait over brush piles. His hawg weighed 5.26 pounds and was good for \$150.00

## LAKE CONDITIONS

It was a great day for catching little bass. The big bass seemed to be suffering from lockjaw. The lake was full from the record rains a few weeks before. The water was stained. The skies were sunny. The winds were out of the SSE 8 mph with gusts up to 15 mph. At 6:00 am the air temp was 79 with humidity at 90% and by 3:30 pm it had climbed to 90 with humidity at 60%. It felt hot all day. The water temp was 81-82. The barometric pressure was almost flat. A 6:00 am it was 29.96 and fell to 29.94 by 3:30 pm. The moon was full the night before. The launch site was challenging with it's one lane ramp and a tricky driveway between the condos at Don's Marina. We held the weigh-in on the service dock and the devo on the grass under the trees next to the ramp. The Media boys were fishing too. Twenty-five of them launched their boats out of Log Cabin.
